# ALLEN STUCHBERY MEMORIAL MALE & FEMALE AGGREGATE AWARDS



These will be determined by the AV Shield points system and looking for **OUTSTANDING, CONSISTENT, AND ATHLETES WHO COMPETE ON A REGULAR BASIS**. Allen Stuchbery (8.3.1922-26.7.1993). In 1938, Allen joined the Victorian Railways Institute Amateur Athletics Club. In 1939, at the age of 17, he won the Victorian Junior 3 mile and 1-mile championships. His athletics was interrupted with World War II until he won the South Australian 1 mile and 1/2 mile championships setting new state records. His best for 800m was 1:56:5. The 1956 Melbourne Olympics stirred him to renew his interest and with Ray Foley started up the South Bendigo Amateur Athletics Club and was their first coach. Around 1964, he and Trevor Billingham initiated Bendigo Little Athletics, with Allen being the first president. In 1970, Allen won the National 40 and over 10 mile title and finished fourth in an Open marathon with a time of 2hrs 43min. In the years following, Allen's heart deteriorated which culminated with open-heart surgery in 1984. Allen returned to athletics with field events in the 1990's and had success winning medals at the Masters games in distant events.
